

OFSAA TRACK AND FIELD 2002 LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

A sum of \$150 to be awarded to one male and one female track and field student-athlete who has competed in the sport of track and field at a Bay of Quinte member school.

Criteria

- must be in his/her graduating year
- must attend a Canadian post-secondary school
- must be in good academic standing
- must have displayed characteristics of good sportsmanship and commitment to the sport throughout their high school career.
- must have qualified for OFSAA Track and Field at least once in their high school career.

Potential Candidates are to apply, in writing, through their teacher-coach. The teacher-coach will then send this to the Bay of Quinte Track and Field Convenor(s) who will coordinate the selection process.

The candidate shall provide a write up of their track and field accomplishments throughout their high school career and explain why they feel they deserve consideration of the award. Submissions must be typed.

DEADLINE:

To the Bay of Quinte Track and Field Convenors no later than May 31 of the current school year.
